

2021 in Review

- 1. Two key strategic areas of work focused on were:
- The Enhanced OGA Welfare Policy

The WGHS OGA Tertiary Education Scholarship Scheme for Bright and Needy Students

2. Major Challenges

The implementation of the No Fasting Policy in the School and its resultant negative repercussion on the image of the school. This led to the constitution of the 7-member Special Committee on School Rules, Regulations and Related Matters chaired by HE Mrs Difie Agyarko Kusi of the 1966 YG and Mrs Rosemund Keteku of the 1972 YG was the Secretary.

An Interim Report was subsequently submitted to the OGA National Executive, and a copy has been sent to the Presiding Bishop of the Methodist Church, Ghana, who is the Chairman of the Governing Board of the School.

3. OGs in Distress

A couple of old girls also fell into different forms of distress and the OGA rose to the occasion and came to their rescue.

4. Wrigley Day Celebration

The Wrigley Day celebrations in September, were successfully observed throughout Ghana and the Diaspora with Church Services at the Ghana Tertiary Education Commission Auditorium in Accra, the Good Shepherd Church, South Suntreso in Kumasi and the Wesley Chapel in Cape Coast. Some Old Girls abroad joined the service in Accra virtually.

8. Financial Reports

The Treasurer presented the financial highlights of 2021, and this was followed by the presentation of the audited accounts for the 2021 financial year by the External Auditors, Messrs Franferg Chartered Accountants. On a motion to accept the financial reports Julia Acquah-Harrison of the 1981 YG moved and this was seconded by Gifty Annan-Myers of the 1968 YG. Mr. Ferguson Ofori-Atta of Franferg Chartered Accountants moved for the acceptance of the Audited Report and Financial Statements, and this was seconded by Augusta Wellington of the 1972 YG.

9. Appointment of Auditors

A motion was moved by Harriet Wereko-Brobbey of 1975 YG for the Auditors to be re-appointed. This was seconded by Sefakor Danku of 2006 YG. The Auditors Messrs Franferg Chartered Accountants were therefore re-appointed for the year 2022.

10. Situational Report from the Headmistress

- 11 NSS and 3 NABCO staff (1 teaching and 2 non-teaching)
- WASSCE 2001 692 candidates were presented. 99.20% pass and 87.93% quality grades. 
